Francesca earned her J.D. from <u>American University Washington College of Law</u>, where she held leadership roles in the <u>Transactional Law Society</u>, competed in national negotiation competitions, and served as Senior Trademark & Copyright Articles Editor of the <u>American University Intellectual Property Brief</u>. She is admitted to practice in the <u>District of Columbia</u>, with Maryland admission pending.
